

Supporting the School





The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 3:34 PM.

1. To adopt the Minutes of the 52nd Annual General Meeting of the Association

The motion to adopt the Minutes of the 52nd Annual General Meeting of the Association was proposed by Ronnie KUNG ('86) and seconded by Ka Wing CHAN ('97), then passed unanimously.

2. To adopt the 2022-2023 Annual Report of the Executive Committee of the Association


The Chairman of the Association, along the chairmen of the sub-committees and convenors of fraternities in the Association, reported on activities held in the course of the executive year 2022-2023, all of which were detailed in the 2022-2023 Annual Report of the Executive Committee of the Association.

The motion to adopt the 2022-2023 Annual Report of the Executive Committee of the Association was proposed by Joseph NG ('80) and seconded by Nelson HO ('83), then passed unanimously.

3. To adopt the Balance Sheet, Statement of Accounts and the Auditor's Report for the year ended 31st December 2022

Derrick CHENG ('96), the Honorary Treasurer, presented and explained in detail the financial statements, including income and expenditures of the Association for the year ended 31st December 2022.

The motion to adopt the Balance Sheet, Statement of Accounts and the Auditor's Report for the year ended 31st December 2022 was proposed by Nelson HO ('83) and seconded by Jesse TAM ('97), then passed unanimously.



4. To appoint the Honorary Auditor of the Association for the session 2023-2024

As CHANG LEUNG HUI & LI C.P.A. LIMITED, the current Honorary Auditor of the Association for the session 2022-2023, would not continue to take the role for the next session 2023-24, therefore there was no candidate to be appointed as the Honorary Auditor of the Association for the session 2023-2024. The motion was postponed to the later meetings after the Executive Committee of the Association for the session 2023-24 was elected.

5. To elect the Members of the Executive Committee of the Association for the session 2023-2024

5.1. To introduce the procedure and estimated time required for the upcoming election

The Election Manager Chris CHAN ('96) introduced the procedure for the upcoming election, all of which were detailed in the Procedure List prepared by the Election Manager.

Estimated time required as follow:

- Approximately 148 minutes for 74 nominees who attended the Meeting to introduce themselves

- Approximately 2 hours for votes counting


5.2. To propose to adjourn the Meeting

Yu Leung LEE ('75) expressed that the break was unnecessary as he believed that attendees were ready for the election to start. Therefore, the meeting continued.

5.3. To discuss to streamline the election procedure proposed by the Election Manager

Benny POON ('04) suggested that the distribution of ballots and the introduction of the nominees could take place at the same time to reduce the duration of the election. By simple majority, the proposal passed unanimously.

The meeting was temporarily adjourned at 6:07PM, for the Election Managers and helpers to manage and organize the submitted ballots. The vote counting process was supervised by Ka Lok NG, the Vice Principal of the School.

The Meeting resumed at 8:34PM.


5.5. To announce the results of the Election



The Executive Committee (referred as EXCO hereafter) of the Wah Yan College Kowloon Past Students' Association Limited (referred as WYKPSA hereafter) for the session 2023-2024 was elected on 24th June 2023 in the 53rd Annual General Meeting of the WYKPSA.


With much enthusiasm and efforts from both EXCO and non-EXCO members of the WYKPSA, the WYKPSA successfully organized a variety of activities and projects as reported herein.

Reports from the Functional Units

Centenary Celebration Unit

- Centenary Gala Dinner
 - Tom Ho ('81) served as the Chairman of the organizing committee of the WYK Centenary Gala Dinner which consists of members from different stakeholders including alumni, teachers and parents. Due to the overwhelming response, the venue has finally been fixed at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre on 20th December 2024, which can accommodate all Wahyanites under the same roof. The committee has been working hard to finalize the programmes so to bring out the best in this once-in-a-lifetime grand gathering of Wahyanites.
- WYK 100 Editorial and Oral History Sub-Committee

 Under the leadership of Professional Kwok Siu Tong Edmund ('65), a sub-committee "WYK Editorial and Oral History Sub-committee" has been set up under the school's 100 Heritage Development Project. It aims to consolidate, as far as possible, a collective memory of the



hundred years' experience of the staff, and students to better appreciate the heritage and culture of the College. Interviews have been conducted with our teachers, staff and alumni to share their Wah Yan stories; aiming at issuing an anniversary publication in 2025. Tom Ho ('81) and Monty Fong ('83) have been representing the PSA to serve in the sub-committee over the year

Membership Unit

Chris Li ('07) and Monty Fong ('83) served as the Chairmen of the Membership Unit this year. Over 130 new members were recruited in this year, most of registration were received in the S.6 Graduation Dinner and Speech Day in July 2023.

By the end of April 2024, the WYKPSA had 9806 members in total and the ranges of which are from class 1953 to class 2023. However, only 2692 of them were reachable in our contact database. Building up a complete membership database was always our goal, the WYKPSA was planning to update the contact information of all members by class representative.

Recreation & Interest Group Unit

Vincent Leung ('09) served as the Chairman of the Recreation and Interest Group this year. The group has organized two wine tastings, a whisky tasting and a latte art class with over 50 participants attended the events. The events have not only piqued the interest of the participants in wine, whisky and latte art but also gathered alumni from different generations, who shared their times at school, and serve as an additional platform for all to keep up to date with the developments of the school and strengthen the bonding of the alumni community.

Sports Unit

Communication Unit





In addition, as advised by the School management, the A&A should reflect the details related to the School Alumni Manager election that is held in 2024. Therefore, the A&A was subsequently amended and the changes were tabled at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on 22nd March 2024 and adopted.

1. Spring Dinner

The Spring Gala 2024 was successfully held on 23 February 2024 with around 200 participants at K11 Club One, including more than 20 Jesuits Fathers and teachers. 2. Wah Yan International Reunion/International Conference


Carl Wong ('93) is the convenor on behalf of the WYKPSA for the organizing of the 2024 Wah Yan International Reunion/International Conference, one of the important events for Wah Yan alumni around the globe to meet up, exchange ideas and foster bonding. This year's event will be held from December 18-20, 2024, culminating in the centenary celebration of Wah Yan College, Kowloon.

This year's programme for the 2024 event features updates from both schools, the Students' Associations, the Past Students' Associations, overseas chapters and more. To make the event extra exciting, we are dedicating one day for an exclusive tours and company visit. Campus tours will also be arranged for participants to see the latest developments in both schools up close.

3. Election of School Alumni Manager

Under the current ordinance, the Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) of Wah Yan College Kowloon comprises an alumni representative, the so-called "Alumni School Manager". The WYKPSA had been recognized by the IMC as the only alumni association for the purpose of nominating alumni manager. Pursuant to the resolutions passed at the WYKPSA Annual General Meeting 2010, the Alumni Manager shall be elected based on the principle of universal suffrage.

The school had received feedback from the EDB in December 2023 on the Alumni Manager election. The article review committee of WYKPSA had proposed an article amendment in March 2024 to satisfy the requirement suggested by the EDB and the amendment was adopted and approved in the EGM on 22nd March 2024.




The election of Alumni Manager 2024 was started in April 2024, and only one valid registration had been received by the Returning Officer of WYKPSA by the deadline of election registration, which is filed by Kung Chun Hung, Ronnie ('86).

According to the election regulation, in the event that there is only one eligible candidate to run for the election, that candidate will be automatically elected as Alumni Manager. The election result has been formally endorsed by the WYKPSA Executive Committee during the ordinary meeting on 16 May 2024.

4. Student Ambassador Scheme

Starting from 1991, the WYKPSA would select a Student Ambassador to be the bridge of the WYKPSA and current students and promoting good relationship between overseas alumni chapter and PSA in Hong Kong. In general, the Student Ambassador will visit the overseas chapter in summer each year. The overseas visit was stopped for 4 years since 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. After discussion with the WYHKPSA and several overseas chapters, the overseas visit for Student Ambassador will resume in 2024 to the UK chapters in London.

Starting from 2017, the Student Ambassador Scheme was opened for application to all S.5 students. With the assistance of our School, we had interviewed five candidates in November 2023. Leung Kwan Yiu Ryan from Class 5Y had been appointed as the Student Ambassador for the Student Ambassador Scheme 2024.



Pacemaker X Marathon 2024


