The Society of Jesus is pleased to announce that Dr Ying Lun So (蘇英麟) (“Dr. So”) has been appointed Supervisor, with Father John Tang S.J. (湯湧) (“Fr. Tang”) appointed as Assistant Supervisor of Wah Yan College, Kowloon, both with effect from 16 July 2024 until further notice.

Dr. So is currently the Chairman of the Education Commission as well as the Education Delegate of the Chinese Province of the Society of Jesus. A Wahyanite himself, he has extensive leadership experience in secondary education, tertiary education, as well as business.

Since 2014, Fr. Tang has been the Warden of the University of Hong Kong’s Ricci Hall. He is the Chairman of the Youth Commission of the Chinese Province of the Society of Jesus and the Chairman of the Ricci Social Services Foundation in Macau. He holds a Licentiate in Sacred Theology, a Master of Business Administration degree and a medical degree.

Father Wong is currently pursuing his doctorate on Catholicism within the two Wah Yan Colleges. He serves as the current Chairman of the Jesuit Education Board, a member of the Incorporated Management Committee of Wah Yan College, Hong Kong, and in various other capacities within the Jesuit Order and the Catholic Diocese of Hong Kong. His roots with Wah Yan College, Hong Kong, began in 2012 where he taught and has since learnt to serve and love here.

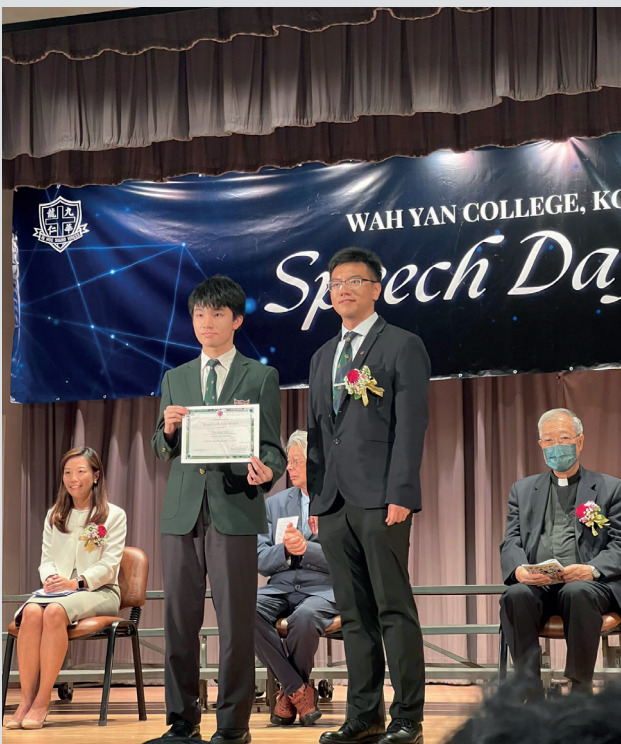

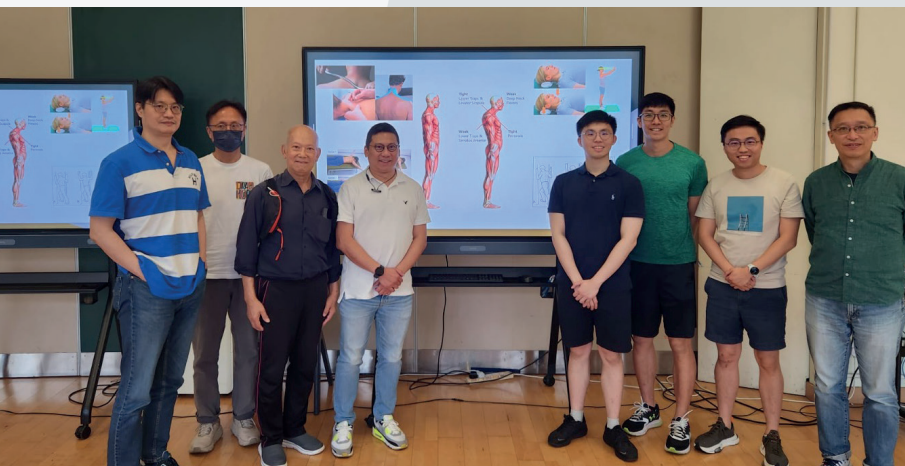
Graduation Dinner 2024

Enrollment is still open at the same ticket price: HKD1,500 per pax, HKD18,000 per table).

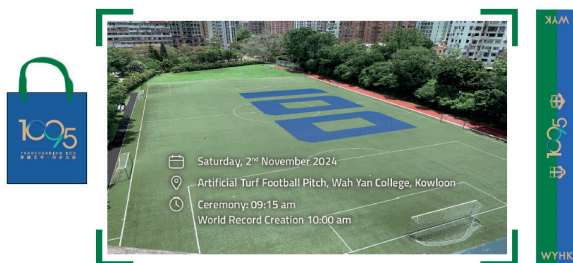
