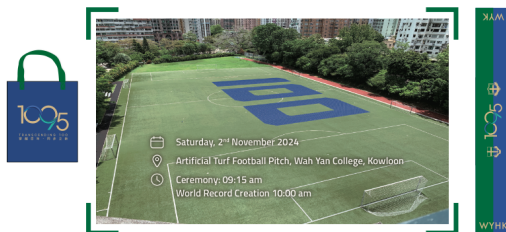
Enrollment
