2024 Guinness World Record Creation Presented by Wah Yan One Family Foundation

The first event of our alma mater's Centenary Celebrations - 2024 World Record Creation Campaign @ Wah Yan has been successfully completed on 2 November 2024.

More than 200 student, parent and alumni volunteers worked together to use 10,000 scarves to build a figure of "100", creating a new world record - the largest number of scarves.

In the afternoon, our volunteers assembled 10,000 blessing bags with these scarves, tea bags, rice packs and health supplements. These blessing bags were then delivered to the elderly at Caritas' day care centres.





Nearly HK\$4 million was raised to support the hiring of more Native-speaking English Teachers and the implementation of STEAM education for both Wah Yans.

Not only is this a record for everyone in the Wah Yan community, it is also a manifestation of what our revered Jesuits have always taught us - be "Men for and with Others".
